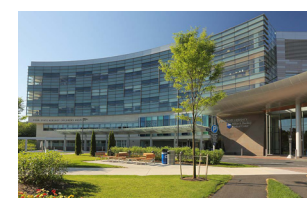
Milton S. Hershey Medical Center – The 548-bed center is the system’s flagship teaching and research hospital. Its Hershey campus includes institutes focused on cancer, heart and vascular disease and the neurosciences. Three times designated as a Magnet hospital.

Penn State Health Hampden Medical Center – A planned 108-bed community hospital that’s expected to open to patients in Hampden Township, Cumberland County, in 2021.



Penn State Health St. Joseph A two-campus community medical center in Berks County (southeastern PA) with an acute care hospital in Bern Township and a downtown Reading campus.

Penn State Health Rehabilitation Hospital – A 98-bed joint venture with Select Medical. Penn State Health physicians provide the clinical care. Located in Hershey, one mile from Hershey Medical Center.

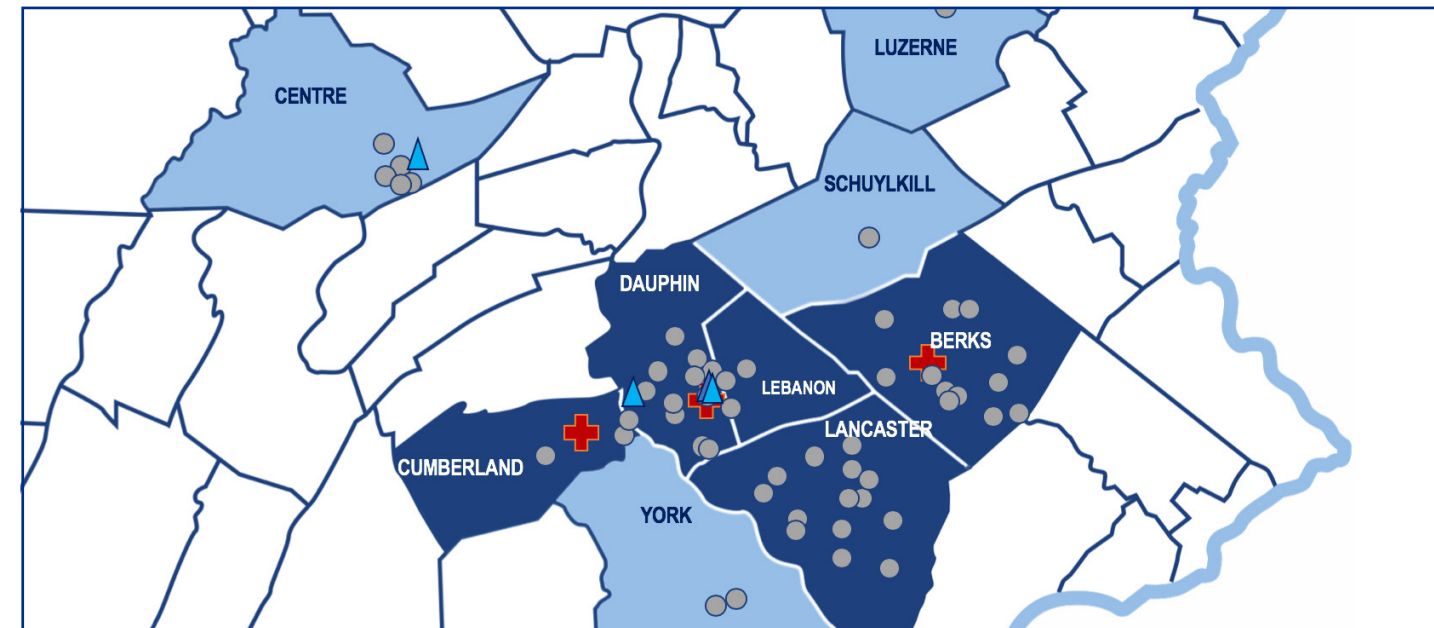


Penn State Children’s Hospital Central Pennsylvania’s only acute care hospital specifically for ill or injured children. Located on the Milton S. Hershey Medical Center campus.

Pennsylvania Psychiatric Institute – A joint venture that provides behavioral health services to children, adolescents and adults in central Pennsylvania and the surrounding region. Penn State Health psychiatric specialists provide patient care at an 89-bed inpatient facility and two outpatient and partial-hospital locations in Harrisburg.
